We investigated leads for two pieces of land and one commercial building. Unfortunately, these leads did not yield positive results. Our biggest hurdle continues to be financing. We have not been able to secure a grant or identify a program that we can execute that will provide grant funding. Commercial loans were not an option and owner financing was not available. We will continue to investigate availability of grants to fund programs using a CAFCI

owned facility and creative ways to obtain financing. Despite the disappointment, let us continue to be patient and hopeful as we work towards finding a home for CAFCI.
